Position Summary: The Maintenance Technician supports M&E activities in all areas of the facility at Gusmer Enterprises. Activities will be determined by need and skill set of the candidate.

The Maintenance Technician must be able to work cooperatively with other maintenance personnel, production, R&D, the quality department, and lab staff.

General Responsibilities:

- 1. Track, maintain and perform preventative maintenance on process, assembly and testing equipment. During this process make minor repairs to tools and equipment as needed and notify proper personnel of required major maintenance.

- 3. Assist in design for updates to equipment or for new equipment.
- 4. Perform fabrication, installation, and troubleshooting of plant equipment
- 5. Other technical or research work as may be assigned.
